**Report from Mike Jackson, Footpath Secretary.**

The footpath committee is working on a number issues.

Skeffling 5. The inspectorate inspected the proposed restricted byway and refused to confirm the order. We are now awaiting the landowners decision on the issue.

Swanland School -We are awaiting the Inspector's report.

West Beck Bridge- The diversion has now been modified and is now usable 12 years after it was constructed

Bilton footpath 3- We have met the chairman of Highways and the landowner on site and rejected another proposed modification. We cannot get a response from ERYC as to when they intend to erect the bridge. CO will not support a section 56 in the crown court.

Bugthorpe footpath 12- We have now agreed to this diversion, after a second meeting with the landowners agent.

Barmby on the Marsh- The addition of Fleet Lane to the definitive map has been confirmed.

Elloughton footpath 4 -. ERYC's Countryside Access Manager has objected to the order on the grounds of crime and safety. It seems the East Riding's officers cannot work together. We have reluctantly accepted it as the best option open to us.

Burton Pidsea Carr House Access Road- The Inspector modified the order from a restricted byway to a BOAT ( which is what we initially asked for ). This meant it had to be readvertised and we are waiting the final outcome.

Hornsea bridleway 16- The diversion has been confirmed.

The ERYC have made an order to divert a deadend bridleway in Burton Pidsea to the highway. We have put in a holding objection in to the order

We have had a large number of consultations, which we are happy with.
