HIGH HUNSLEY CIRCUIT



This 25 mile circular walk visits the villages of Walkington, Skidby, Brantingham, South Cave and Bishop Burton, incorporating small sections of the Wolds Way and Beverley 20 walks.

The High Hunsley Circuit was devised by the late Dennis Parker, former Chairman of our Beverley Group. In order to enjoy this entire route, it is marked on the Kingston upon Hull and Beverley OS Explorer Map No.293 at 1:25,000 scale. The route can be walked as a challenge route in a single day or can be divided into two or three linear sections. It can be started at any point and walked in either direction. Short detours can be made to a number of attractive nearby villages, most of which have a pub and/or tea-room. To obtain an A3 leaflet with a sketch map, further information about a badge on completion, details of useful bus routes, car parking and places of interest close to the route, please send a stamped addressed envelope to David Court, 3 Fairview Close, Beverley, East Yorkshire HU17 7DE

New way marker signs measuring 5cm square with black printing on white showing the roundel above have recently been sourced and will be appearing at strategic points on the route in the near future to help ensure you are on the right path. WALKING SAFETY

Lions Medi-Canisters (also known as Lions Message in a Bottle)

Reference is made to these on the above Walks Participation Register - Fact Sheet. These canisters have been distributed free to Ramblers members for some time now from a supply following a Beverley Group monetary donation to Lions charitable causes. Inside these small waterproof containers is an A4 size sheet that ensures vital information about yourself is available to the Emergency Services. This enables safer and speedier First Aid by short cutting time consuming fact finding enquiries about any patient. These should be carried in your rucksack on any Ramblers walk.

If you do not have one of these Medi-Canisters and would like one, please ask if they are available on the day of your next Beverley Group walk.

On the subject of First Aid, may we recommend an excellent free App from British Red Cross for those in possession of a smart mobile phone. Once the British Red Cross App is downloaded, it is always available, even if there is no mobile signal. The App gives instant access to simple, step-by-step advice together with useful videos and animations including for CPR. Please consider a download from redcross.org.uk/app

BEVERLEY GROUP 2017 COACH RAMBLE

A coach ramble has been arranged to Hathersage, Derbyshire on **Sunday 7th May 2017**. Two walks are planned starting from Heatherdene Car Park and finishing in Hathersage. The 10 mile walk goes north to Derwent Edge, Derwent Moor, Moscar and along Stanage Edge returning to Hathersage.

A shorter 6 to 7 mile walk includes a riverside walk along the Derwent Valley Heritage Way via Bamford Mill finishing in Hathersage. There will be opportunities for refreshments after the walks in Hathersage. Non-walkers will be welcome who will be conveyed to Hathersage. Coach to leave Beverley at 8.00 from the bus stop behind M&S, picking up en-route, if required, at Market Weighton and Pocklington. An estimated arrival back in Beverley is 7.00 pm. The coach will drop all walkers at Heatherdene car park and non-walkers in Hathersage.
