Pocklington Footpath Maintenance Team[s]

We are trying to establish a Team of volunteers to carry out maintenance of rights of way in the East Riding area.

This will be low level unsupervised work e.g. removing overhanging /encroaching hedging: knocking down bramble/nettles/overgrowth etc. replacing finger posts and signs: repairing gates and stiles: replacing faded/removed arrows: fitting new hand rails to bridges. NB: muscle not required, just commitment!

Most of the work will be generated through reports from Ramblers members, the public and parish path surveys.

A successful meeting has been held with ERYC Countryside Access to discuss a provisional plan relating to equipment, transport, volunteer days needed, insurance, grants, liaison etc.

At present only 4 members have expressed positive interest. To be effective we need about 10/12 whereby a couple of teams can always be assembled.

So - if you are interested in maintaining the network of rights of way that we are all constantly using then **please contact me ASAP**. If sufficient numbers come forward a get together will be arranged for fuller discussion and organisation.

April is a provisional start date and it would be great if Pocklington Group members could contribute towards maintaining our local countryside.
