

Survey of Pocklington Group Parish Paths

To ensure our rights of way are in good condition it is advisable to survey them at least every 2 years. As spring and summer approach now is the best time to do it. Previously, there has only been five of us, completing one or more of the 47 parishes, so some help would be appreciated.

It is a straightforward process of walking paths, checking they and the signs, stiles, gates etc are without problem. If not, to note details of the problem on a map and where possible take a photo. Maps are available for each parish showing their footpaths. Also a map of parishes making up Pocklington group territory is on the area website
